REQUEST FOR AUCTION EVENTS

Dear Saint Andrew Parishioners,

As we begin to plan in earnest for the 2011 Wearin' The Green event (WTG), we'd like to ask for your help to fill an important area of need.

As you may know, WTG is the parish and school's largest fundraiser of the year and the major driver of its success and revenue is the live/silent auction.

To build on past success, our goal for this year's auction is to incorporate more of a historically popular item: Parishioner/parent-generated "auction events."

What is an "Auction Event?"

Small-group, themed, social events hosted by parishioners/parents that serve as great opportunities to build community in addition to raising money for WTG.

Examples of past events ranged from adult to child-oriented themes such as:

- Oktoberfest Progressive Party – a three-stage/house dinner based on the food and drink of Germany
- Chili Cook-Off – the "top chef"-like clash of Saint Andrew's finest chili recipes
- Beer, Braids & Brats – a cookout where Dads get a lesson in the finer points of creating pigtails

How it works:

The format is simple: One or more families from each class (the host) come up with a unique theme/idea, cover the costs of any food/materials needed, set a price per person/couple and decide how many participants can attend. The event is then offered as a sign-up auction item at WTG.

As this is as much about community-building as it is about raising money, we encourage multiple families to host together.

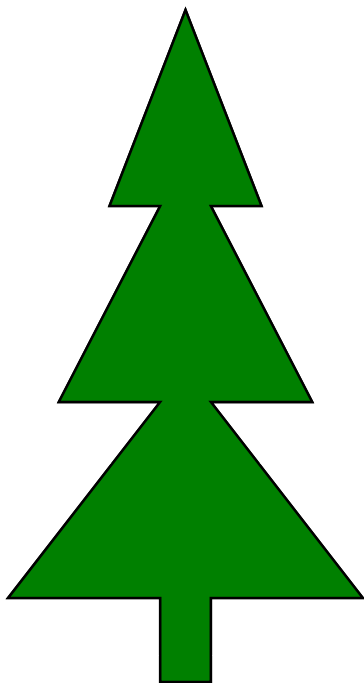
