ARE YOU RICH?

Are you financially rich?

Think about it. You live in one of the wealthiest and most resource-consuming nations on the planet. Despite this fact, my guess is not many of us would pop ourselves into the “rich” category.

Today’s readings seem a lot about “categories”—specifically opposing categories: rich/poor, heaven/hell, right behavior/wrong behavior, reward/punishment.

Did you find yourself doing a little dance in your head as the readings progressed, deciding which of those categories applied to you? Which ones did not? Did you feel good about yourself? Or maybe guilty?

The dance is familiar, almost natural. Our brains want to decipher, sort, and label. But is there another message evident? Something beyond the cursory judgments of our “moral barometer?” Could we establish something more challenging, more lasting to our faith?

What strikes me in the Gospel as particularly relevant is not that the rich man suffers because he is rich, or that Lazarus is rewarded because he is poor. No, what strikes me is that Lazarus “would gladly have eaten his fill of the scraps that fell from the rich man’s table.” Underlying this statement is a fundamental outlook of gratitude and faith in God. Conversely, underlying the rich man’s life is an obvious void. While he fulfilled every material desire, he never saw his wealth as an obstacle to a life “well-lived.” He never purposefully hurt Lazarus, but he missed a tremendous opportunity to become closer to God by caring for the least of his brothers and sisters. His error is rooted in an omission of love.
